Launch of UniSAFE survey field implementation

Gender-based violence is a complex, prevalent, persistent feature and force in many organisations, including universities and research organisations. Without sufficient knowledge, infrastructure and measures in place, it is difficult to fully prevent, protect or even prosecute.

To provide measurable evidence on prevalence of gender-based violence in universities and research organisations, UniSAFE is coordinating a survey among [46 participating research performing organisations in the EU](#).

The first survey field implementation launched on 17 January 2022. The survey will be conducted for one month among each of the participating organisations' staff and students, between January and April 2022.

Survey results will be integrated with qualitative evidence in a multi-level study design, analysed and translated into operational tools for research performing organisations and policymakers.
